

Administrative action in the event of ragging in Sreekrishnapuram V T Bhattathiripad college

Depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely:

- 1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- 2. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- 3. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- 4. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- 5. Cancellation of admission. 8. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.

5. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period. Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

Under the pretext of 'welcoming' new students to the college, ragging is a practice that gives senior students an excuse to harass their junior counterparts and make them easy targets to satiate their own pleasures. The students of Sreekrishnapuram V T Bhattathiripad College are here by warned that they shall not indulge in "RAGGING".
