1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution:

Sreekrishnapuram V. T. Bhattathiripad College is one of the affiliated college under the University of Calicut. Established in 1982, with the aim to provide quality education to the poor and socio-economically backward students of Palakkad, the college continues to function in a manner befitting its aims. It is functioning in an area where higher education facilities are less .The college continued its services during the current academic year also.

The college applied for various programmes to the University of Calicut and is awaiting its decision.

3.Innovations in curricular design and transaction:

The college lays emphasis on achieving an ideal system of teaching-learning and evaluation to impart quality education to students. The traditional methods of teaching are supplemented with audio/video/computer assisted learning techniques. New green boards were purchased for all the Departments. Most of the Departments are using computers and LCD projector for their teaching and conduct of student seminars and presentations.

Being an affiliated college, the college functions according to CCSS programme of the University of Calicut.
