Part II: Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution

Sreekrishnapuram V. T. Bhattathiripad College is one of the affiliated colleges under the University of Calicut established in 1982 with the aim to provide quality education to the poor and socio-economically backward students of Palakkad. The college continues to function in a manner befitting its aims.

1. New academic programmes initiated (UG & PG):

The college applied for various programmes to the University of Calicut and is awaiting its decision.

2. Innovations in curricular design and transaction:

The college lays emphasis on achieving an ideal system of teaching-learning and evaluation to impart quality education to students. The traditional methods of teaching are supplemented with audio/video/computer assisted learning techniques. New green boards were purchased for

all the departments. Most of the departments are using computers and LCD projector / OHP for teaching, conduct of student seminars and presentations.

3. Interdisciplinary programmes initiated:

- Certificate course in Computer application.
- Certificate course in functional English.

4. Examination reforms implemented:

Being an affiliated college, the college functions according to CCSS programme of the University of Calicut. In every semester, the student progress is constantly monitored through periodic test papers / assignments / seminars and model examinations. Internal evaluation of UG and PG programmes are being carried out as per the guidelines of the University of Calicut.

5. Candidates qualified in NET/SLET/GATE etc.

As per the information available, a total of 5 students have qualified NET/SLET/GATE and similar examinations.

6. Initiative towards faculty development programme:

All the senior teachers of the college had completed the required Orientation and Refresher programmes as per UGC regulations. All the newly recruited teachers are awaiting to attend orientation programmes. Several teachers have participate in National /State level / seminars and workshops. Several staff have decided to apply for Minor and Major Projects funded by UGC.

7. Total number of seminars/workshops conducted:

Various departments have carried out a series of seminars at the regional level. The important ones include:

- V. T. Day celebration in February
- Legal Literacy Seminar, conducted by NSS .Many academic Programmes are conducted by NSS in connection with Independence day, Republic day and other days of National importance.
- Departments of Sanskrit, Mathematics, History, Economics, Commerce and Computer science have conducted regional level seminar programmes.

The college plays an active role in community services through its many faceted activities. The college has one of the best NSS Units under the University of Calicut Blood donation. Many programme such as tree planting campaign, anti-drug and alcohol day, Nagasaki Day, Teacher’s Day, blood group determination and blood donation, cleaning public places like bus stand and hospital, camps for volunteers, campaigns for birth control and AIDS prevention, legal awareness class were conducted by NSS Unit.

18. Teachers and officers newly recruited:

Three Assistant Professors, two in Commerce and one in Economics were appointed.

Books were purchased using UGC fund year or early next year.

- Technology upgradation:

Computer is available to all the Departments for their teaching and administrative activities. Broadband internet facility is available in the Library for use by staff and students free of cost. The number of computers in the college will be increased soon.

26. Financial aid to students:

Various endowments and awards are available to the meritorious students. Students of the college had secured many scholarships constituted by Govt.of Kerala, and Govt of India like Suvarna jubilee scholarship, State merit Scholarship etc. Our Sanskrit students had secured Scholarships constituted by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit Kalady and RSS Deemed University New Delhi. Our students are getting conveyance allowance and E-grantz constituted by Government.

27. Activities and support from Alumni Association:

The old students of the college maintain their contact with the college through the Alumni Association. It supports the academic and infrastructural needs of the college.

28. Activities and support from Parent-Teacher Association:

An active PTA functions in the college and plays a key role in the development of the institution. PTA funds are used for the development of infrastructure facilities and for purchase of library books. PTA also provides partial financial support for the conduct of seminars and cultural activities in the college and also provides grants for poor students and honours meritorious students every year.

29. Health Services:

No clinic or health centre functions in the campus. But NSS conducts medical camps and blood group detection programmes from time to time. The college maintains a blood donor's list for use in emergencies.

30. Performance in sports activities:

The college performed excellently in many events at the University, Zonal and also in the National levels in many events during the year 2010-11.

As in the previous years, our academic achievements were quite commendable.

Overall pass percentage was more than 84% for UG and 92 % for P. G. This Year Sanskrit Degree Students of this Institution secured the all the three Ranks in University of Calicut
