Part 2

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution:

Sreekrishnapuram V T Bhattathirippad college is one of the affiliated colleges under the University of Calicut. Established in 1982, with the aim to provide quality education to the poor and socio-economically backward students of Palakkad, the college continues to function in a manner befitting its aims. It is functioning in an area where higher education facilities are less. The college has been continuing its services during the current academic year also.

2. New academic programme initiated (UG & PG)

The college has applied for various programmes to the University of Calicut and is awaiting its decision

3. Innovation in curriculum design and transaction:

The college lays emphasis on achieving an ideal system of teaching-learning and evaluation, in order to impart quality education to the students. The traditional methods of teaching are supplemented with audio video computer assisted learning techniques. New green boards have been purchased for all the Departments. Most of the Departments use computers and LCD projector /OHP in their classrooms to aid teaching and conducting student seminars and presentations.

4. Interdisciplinary programmes started:

1. The certificate Course in Computer Application

5. Examination reforms implemented:

Being an affiliated college, the college functions according to CCSS programme of the University of Calicut. During every semester, the student progress is constantly monitored

through periodic test papers /assignments/seminars and model examinations. Internal evaluation of UG and PG programmes are also carried out as per the guidelines of the University of Calicut.

6. Candidates qualified in NET/SLET/GATE etc.

As per the information available, a total of 4 students have qualified in NET SLET GATE and similar examinations.

7. Initiatives towards faculty development programme:

All senior teachers of the college have completed the necessary orientation and refresher programmes as per the UGC regulations. The newly recruited teachers are to attend orientation programmes in near future as well. The teachers also participate in National / State level/ seminars and workshops very often. Several members of the staff have decided to apply for Minor and Major Projects funded by UGC.

The college organized a series of seminars and academic programmes at the regional level. The important ones include:

1. V.T.Day celebration conducted in February.
2. Legal Literacy Seminar ,conducted by NSS.Several academic programmes were conducted by NSS in connection with Independence day ,Republic day and other days of national importance.
3. Regional level seminar programmes conducted by the departments of Sanskrit,Matemetics,History,Economics,Commerce and Computer science.

The college has applied for UGC assistance under the UG Development Grant, P.G. Development Grant and Grants under "Merged Schemes", under the 11th Plan. The college is also planning to apply for assistance under various schemes.

18. Community services:

The college plays an active role in rendering community services through its multi faceted activities. The college has one of the best NSS Units under the University of Calicut. A blood group determination and blood donation programme was conducted by the NSS Unit. The NSS also organized various programmes such as tree planting campaign, anti-drug and alcohol day, Nagasaki Day, Teacher's Day, cleaning of public places like bus stand and hospital, camps for volunteers, campaigns for birth control and AIDS prevention, legal awareness class etc.

19. Teachers and officers newly recruited:

Three new teachers were appointed in the last academic year, one each in History, English and Mathematics departments.

21. Improvements in the library services:

A part of the UGC fund has been utilized to purchase books this year, and the balance will be utilized early next year.

22. New books/journals subscribed:

Books and journals were purchased for each department.

It has been effectively implemented in all the departments.

25. Computerization of administration and the process of admissions and examination results, issue of certificates:

The processes of preparation of Rank Lists, Admissions have been fully computerized for the last 10 years or so. The administrative section is also being computerized in a phased manner. At the present stage, salary bills and other financial bills are prepared with the aid of computer.

26. Improvement in infrastructural facilities:

Constructed new Auditorium and staff rooms

27. Technology up gradation:

Computers are available to all the departments for teaching and administrative activities. Broadband internet facility has been made available in the library for staff and students, free of cost. The number of computers in the college will be increased soon.

28. Financial aid to students:

Various endowments and awards are granted to the meritorious students. Students of the college have secured many scholarships constituted by Govt. of Kerala and Govt. of India like suvarna jubilee scholarship, state merit scholarship etc. Many Sanskrit students secured scholarships constituted by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit Kalady and RSS Deemed University, New Delhi. The students also receive conveyance allowance and E-Grants allotted by the Government.

29. Activities and support from Alumni Association:

The old students of the college maintain their contact with the college through the Alumni Association. It supports the Academic and infrastructural needs of the college.

30. Activities and support from Parent-Teacher Association:

An active PTA functions in the college and plays a key role in the development of the institution. PTA funds are utilized for the development of infrastructural facilities and for purchase of library books. PTA also provides partial financial support for conducting seminars and cultural activities in the college, provides grants for poor students and honours for meritorious students every year.

31. Health services:

No clinic or health centre functions in the campus. But NSS conducts medical camps and blood group detection programmes from time to time. The college maintains a blood donor's list for use in emergencies.

32 Performance in sports activities:

The college performed excellently in many events at the University, Zonal and also national levels during the year 2010-11.

34. Student achievements and awards:

As in the previous years, our academic achievements were quite commendable. The overall pass percentage was more than 84% for UG and 92% for P.G. This year Sanskrit degree students of this institution have secured the first three Ranks in University of Calicut.

A career Guidance and Placement Cell functions in the college, which is actively involved in providing guidance and counseling to the students. Students are provided with information about various courses, competitive examinations, scholarships, job opportunities etc.
