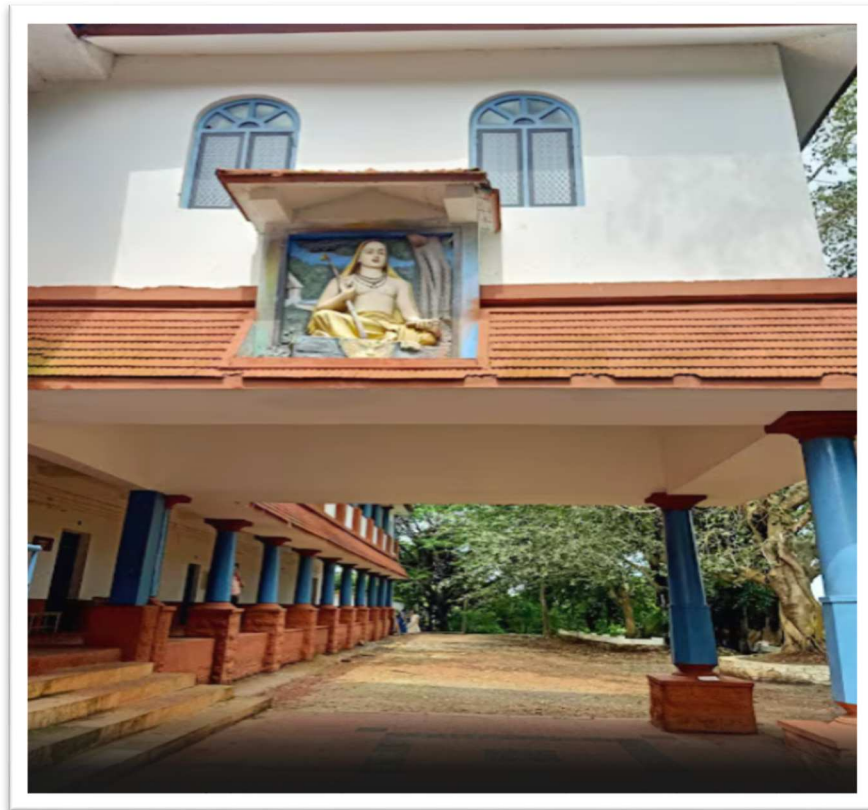

The land for the college was generously donated by the local Namboothiri community.

In Palakkad District, the Trust established Sreekrishnapuram V T Bhathathirippad College, affiliated with the University of Calicut. Named after the esteemed social reformer and writer V.T. Bhattathiripad, this government-aided institution also offers a wide range of undergraduate to postgraduate courses.

Another institution established by the Trust is Sree Sankara Vidyapeetom College, situated in the Nagaroor valleys of Thiruvananthapuram District. Affiliated with the University of Kerala, this self-financing college is located on a sprawling 30-acre campus, offering tremendous potential for future growth into a prominent educational complex. It provides a variety of courses from undergraduate to postgraduate levels. Additionally, Sree



Sankara College in Nagaroor, Thiruvananthapuram District, was established in 2018. This government-aided college, also affiliated with the University of Kerala, offers a range of undergraduate courses and is committed to providing quality education and fostering a supportive learning environment.

Through these institutions, Sree Sankara Trust continues to uphold its commitment to educational excellence and social welfare, guided by the progressive values and philosophies of Jagadguru Sree Sankaracharya.

PROFILE OF THE INSTITUTE

Sreekrishnapuram V. T. Bhattathiripad College, a distinguished government-aided institution affiliated with the University of Calicut, was founded in 1982. Situated in the rural and underdeveloped region of Sreekrishnapuram in Kerala's Palakkad district, the college is named in honour of V. T. Bhattathiripad, a prominent social reformer in Kerala's history. Its primary objective is to enhance higher education opportunities in the region.

Managed by the Sree Sankara Trust - a charitable organization rooted in the principles of Adi Sankaracharya, the esteemed Advaita Vedanta philosopher - the college upholds the values of this renowned theologian from the Namboothiri community.

Initially established as a junior college offering two Pre-Degree programs, the institution expanded its academic offerings in 1991 with the introduction of a Bachelor of Arts in Sanskrit. By 2001, it achieved first-grade status with the launch of a Master of Science in Computer Science. Today, Sreekrishnapuram V. T. Bhattathiripad College provides a diverse range of academic programs, including six undergraduate and three postgraduate degrees.



The college's commitment to quality education is evidenced by its recognition under sections 12(B) and 2(f) of the UGC Act 1956, as confirmed by a letter from the UGC Secretary dated March 20, 2000. In 2016, it received a B+ grade re-accreditation from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), further highlighting its adherence to academic and operational standards.

Dedicated to serving the educational needs of students in rural areas, Sreekrishnapuram V. T. Bhattathiripad College strives to foster academic excellence and promote social responsibility. 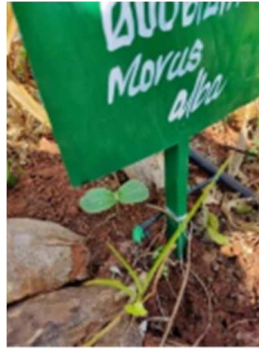

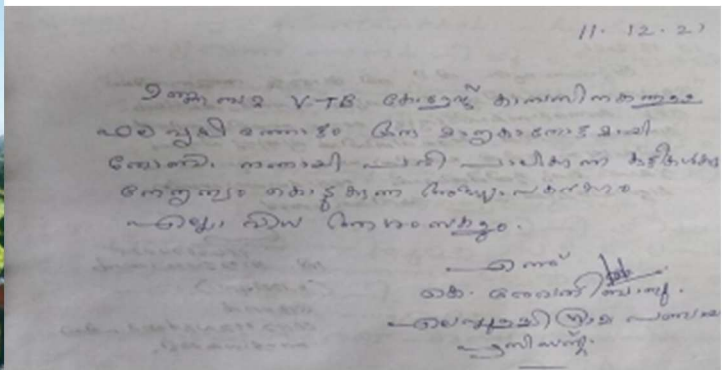

UGC STRIDE Component I Project

STRIDE envisages creation of trans-disciplinary researchers among graduate, post-graduate doctoral and post-doctoral student population in HEIs. The students admitted to HEIs come from various locales having different socio-cultural background. These students may be encouraged to conduct systematic study of locale specific socio-economic problems under the guidance of senior faculty/researchers for their degree dissertations and quality publications. The locale specific socio-cultural perspective of the researchers along with the use of rigorous methodology would yield suitable solutions to the problems under study. Further, this exercise will



train and ignite the young minds to look at the nuances of socioeconomic reality and reflect on different problem-solving methods. It will encourage them to work on the research projects and provide an opportunity to interact with the senior researchers at all stages and give them a mature perspective of research.

The main objectives of STRIDE are:

1. To identify young talent, strengthen research culture, build capacity, promote innovation and support trans-disciplinary research relevant to national development and to enhance the overall well-being of society.
2. To fund high impact national network projects in the identified thrust areas in Humanities and human sciences, and Indian knowledge systems.

Research grant support through STRIDE has three components:

Component-1: Research Capacity Building and Human Resource Development focused on colleges and Universities [All disciplines] (Duration – up to 3 Years).

Component-2: Trans-Disciplinary Research and Inclusive Innovation for National Development [All disciplines] (Duration – up to 3 Years)

Component-3: High Impact Trans-disciplinary Research in Humanities and Human Sciences [Includes thrust areas in following subjects (not limited to) - Philosophy, History, Archaeology, Anthropology, Psychology, Liberal Arts, Linguistics, Indian Languages and Culture, Indian Knowledge Systems, Law, Education, Journalism, Mass Communication, Commerce, Management, Environment and Sustainable Development] (Duration – up to 5 Years) STRIDE Component-1 will endeavour to identify the motivated young talents with research and innovation aptitude in universities and colleges. The Scheme will provide research capacity building



opportunities in diverse disciplines by mentoring, nurturing and supporting young talents.

STRIDE Component-2 will be mainly focused on enhancing problem solving skills with the help of inclusive innovation and action research to innovate pragmatic solutions for local, regional, national priorities to contribute to India's developing economy.

STRIDE Component-3 will fund high impact research projects in the identified thrust areas in humanities and human sciences through multi institutional network. All the applications should be submitted via UGC-STRIDE online application portal. Relevant details will be updated on the website time to time. The selection of projects will be based on merit to be critically evaluated with help of expert peer review, Scientific Advisory Committee (SAC), Search-cum-Selection Committee (SSC) and Project Monitoring Committee (PMC) to be appointed by the UGC.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT CLUB

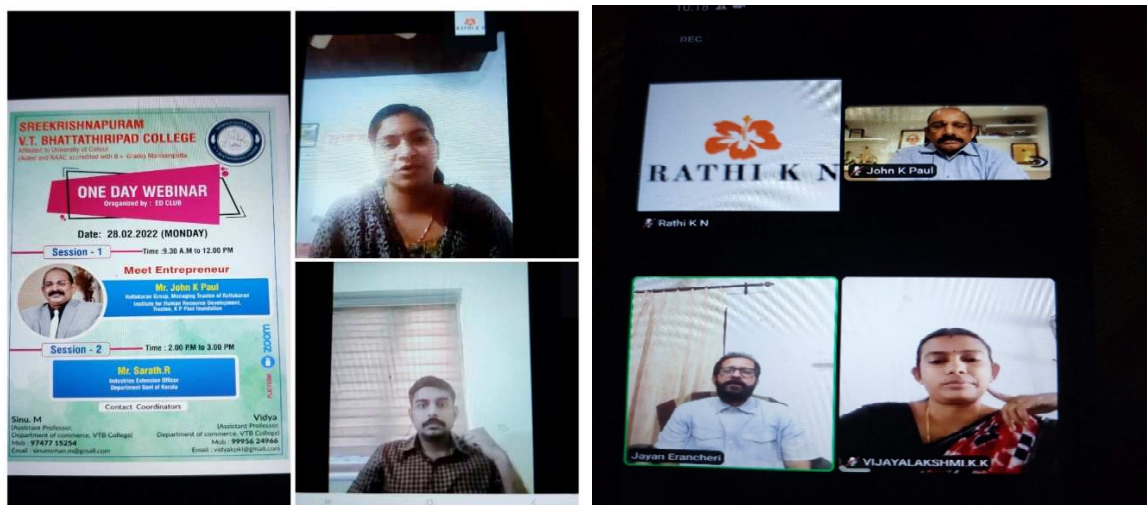

Professor, Department of Commerce expressed Vote of Thanks the gathering.



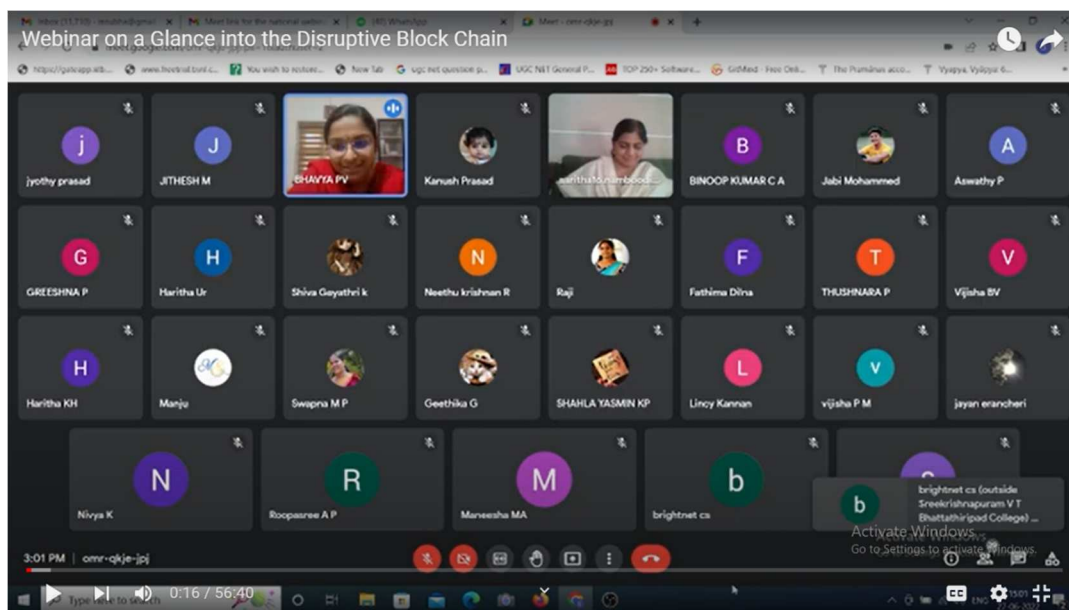

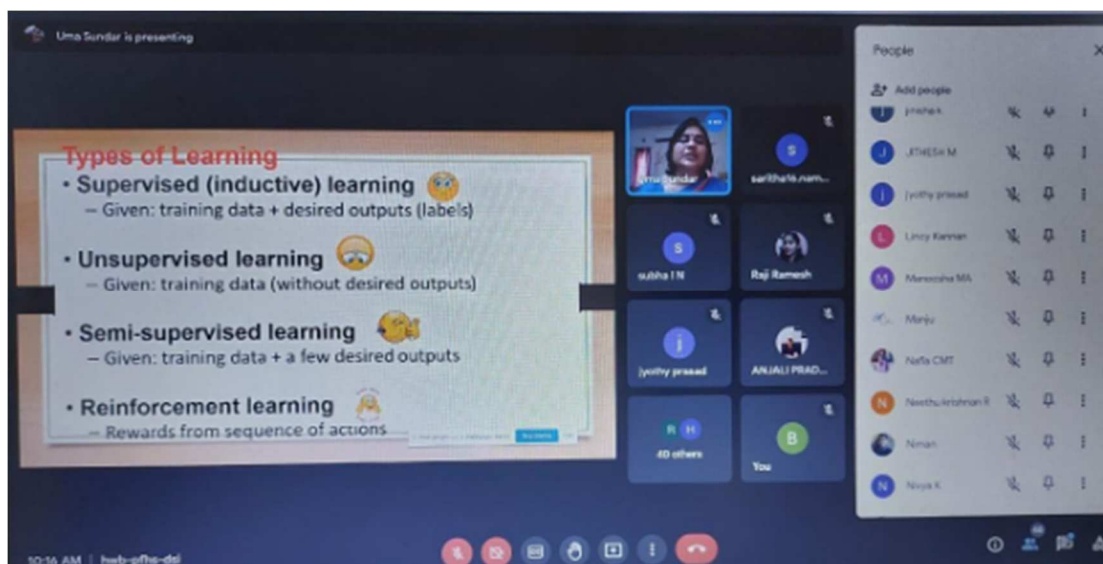




National Seminar on Research Insights into Machine Learning

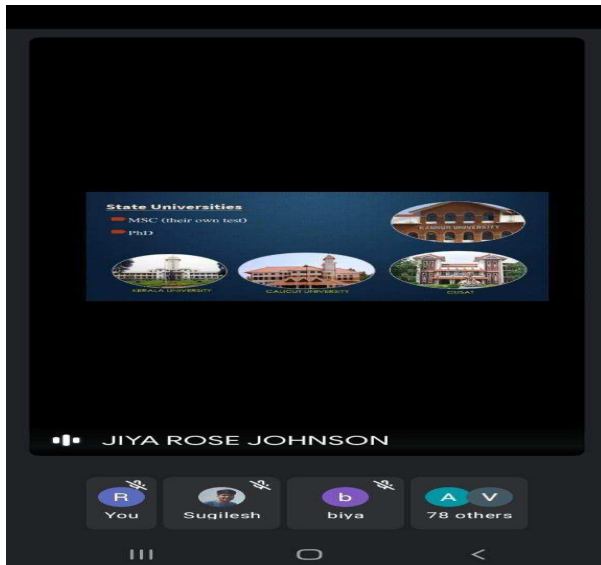
Department of Mathematics
