
20. Give three observation / suggestions to improve the overall teaching - learning experience in your institution

251 responses were received from all the departments of the college and the result is analyzed.




# DATA ANALYSIS AND INTERPRETATION

93% of the participants were of the opinion that the syllabus was covered on time.


2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



Regarding teacher's preparation, 17.5% students opinion that teachers prepare thoroughly and 72.4% students think that teachers' preparation is satisfactory.




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



58.6% of the students say that the communication of teachers was effective. It indicates that the teachers shall be more effective in communication.


4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as



Almost 93% of the students say that teachers' approach was either excellent or very good or Good.




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.



93% of the respondents say that the internal evaluation process was either excellent or Very Good or Good.


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



17.2% of respondents say that the teachers never discussed the performance in assignments with them. That means teachers have to discuss a little more with the students regarding the performance in assignments.




7. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you.



Students are satisfied with the teaching and mentoring process of the teachers.


8. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



65% of respondents agree or strongly agree with this statement. It implies that the remaining respondents have not agreed. This indicates that the institution has to give more opportunities to grow for the students.




9. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.



65.5% of students are aware of the expectations of teachers and programme outcomes and course outcomes of their syllabus.


10. Your mentor does a necessary follow up with an assigned task to you.



65.5% of Students are satisfied with the follow-up activities of the mentors. So mentors have to be more effective.




11. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




Almost 76% of the respondents were satisfied with the illustration style of the teachers.

12. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.




As far as teachers ability to identify the strengths and encourage the students, 66% of the respondents are satisfied.

As far as teachers' ability to identify the weaknesses and encourage the students, 66% of the respondents are satisfied.


14. The institutions make effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.



69% of students are satisfied with their participation in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement process.




15. The institute / teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.



34% of the respondents do not believe that the teachers use student-centric methods of teaching.


16. Teachers encourage to participate in extracurricular activities.



1/4th of the respondents have no opinion regarding the teachers' encouragement towards extra-curricular activities. So teachers shall focus on this point.




17. Efforts are made by the institute / teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.



62% of the respondents are satisfied with the teacher's effort to enhance soft skills among the students.


18. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?
