



ADMISSION POLICY

The admission policy of the college aims to provide an inclusive educational environment that welcomes all students seeking knowledge, irrespective of their caste, gender, or social status. As an affiliated college of the University of Calicut, the admission procedures of UG and PG programmes are in accordance with the norms set by the University. The University implemented centralized admission in the year 2014, with the college serving as a nodal centre. An Admission Nodal Officer appointed by the Principal is in charge of the procedures followed for the admission process. A committee, comprised of both Teaching and Non-teaching Faculty members, diligently execute the process in adherence to the instructions provided by the university. The seats are filled as per the reservation chart issued by the university.
